



Minneapolis VA to Host Provider Fair and Appreciation Event for Community Providers Caring for Veterans

The Minneapolis VA Health Care System will host a Provider Fair and Appreciation Event on Wednesday, June 15, in the auditorium of the Minneapolis VA Medical Center, One Veterans Drive, Minneapolis, MN 55417.

The event is for medical care providers who currently or previously treated Veterans under the VA's various non-VA care funding programs. Clinicians, office staff and business managers are encouraged to attend.

The purpose of the event is twofold: first, to enroll providers in a new VA program that allows faster payment in the Veterans Choice Program (VCP); and, second, to offer providers an opportunity to meet Minneapolis VA leaders and tour the facility.

The event will be held at two times – 3 pm and 5 pm – to accommodate the schedules of attendees. Free parking is available.
