- Minnesota is experiencing large increases in its 65+ population.
- As the age wave continues, we will see record numbers of old people who need long-term care.
- This will put pressure on the state budget, especially in the programs that pay for health and long-term care services.
- The Minnesota Department of Human Services, together with several other state agencies, has been working on strategies to reduce the demand for public monies to pay for these services and find new ways to forge a public/private partnership in the marketplace.
